- Center aligned 'Bibliography' title 1" down from top of page
- Leave 2 blank lines below 'Bibliography' title
- Period at the end of citation
- Use a hanging indent for citations that are more than one line
- Single space, blank line space between citations
- List in alphabetical order
- 'Bibliography' page goes after the body of your research paper
