- Last name and page number ½” down from top of page and right aligned
- ‘Works Cited’ title is centered and 1” down from top of page
- Use a hanging indent for citations that are more than one line
- Include doi (or url) at the end of citation when referenced
- Place a period at the end of each citation
- Double space
- Do not add additional line space between entries
- ‘Works Cited’ page goes after the body of your research paper
